

Tracts of lands containing two hundred and fifty acres, be the same more or less, the land lying on the branches of the Enoree and Ruddy Rivers, bounded as followeth, beginning on a Stake Corner on Elliott Clardy's line at a branch thence up the branch to a Stake Corner, made by David M. Daniel, Thomas Springfield and Jesse Griffens, thence a Conditional line North by to a Stake Corner on the grassy branch, thence up the said branch to a Stake Corner on a line run by George Salmon, thence S. 6. E. to a lightwood Stake Corner, thence S. 81. E. to a Chestnut Corner, thence to the head of the Stake prong of the beginning branch at a Stake Corner on the original line, thence S. 10. E. to a Stake Corner on a Conditional line made by Henry Hall and Joseph Patton thence said Conditional line to a Stake Corner, made by Page Puckel & Harris Puckell, thence a Stake line to a Maple Corner at the mouth of said M. Daniel, and Henry Hall's Spring branch, thence up the north prong of said branch to the head, thence a Conditional line to a Stake Corner on the original line, thence the original line to a Chestnut Corner, thence a Conditional line made between said Hall and Elliott Clardy to a Stake Corner, thence a Straight line running North East 15. to the beginning Corner on said branch. Together with all and singular the rights, member here detaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Hawkins, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors admors and assigns to war, ant & forever defend the above mentioned premises from me and from my heirs and from any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof; to the said William Hawkins and his heirs for ever. In Witness whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this twentieth day of October 1817.
