

George Long of the state aforesaid have granted & doth by their presents, sell & release to s^d George Long fifty acres of land more or less lying in Greenville district on branches of Stony Creek waters of Rudy run being a part originally granted to George Seaborn lying as follows beginning on a post oak, Running N.W. to a post oak, thence S.E. to a ^{thing} white oak, thence S.E. to Tho^s Long, said line, thence Eastward by on s^d Long's line to a spanish oak, thence north to the beginning corner, concluding fifty acres, more or less. Together with all and singular that appertains, to s^d land & premises before mentioned to the s^d George Long his heirs & assigns forever, Lastly I the s^d Tho^s Dyer doth hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the above described land & premises to the s^d George Long his heirs & assigns from all claims that now is or may be made by any person whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. South Carolina, I know all by these presents that I Thomas Dyer of Greenville district and state aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by John Moore of the district & state aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said ^{John} Moore a plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the district & state aforesaid on a small branch of rock creek waters of Paddy River it being a part of a tract of land belonging to the Estate of Jas^s Seaborn deceased and sold at his sale the land to be conveyed begins on B.C. 3X on Beldings line runs N41.W 15 to corner 3X 974 W 45 to stake at the head of branch, then down the meanders of said branch to perimou 3X 970 W to stake on the out line of s^d old survey, then with that old line to Sarny Cotes corner, thence direct ^{line} to the beginning containing one hundred & fifty acres, or the same more or less.
