

343 State of South Carolina Greenville district, Know all men by these presents that I Henry Brasher of Greenville district & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars paid by Brasher Henderson of the State aforesaid have granted & doth by these presents sell & release to said Brasher Henderson one hundred & fifty acres of land, more or less lying in Greenville district, on the East side of Rocky Creek: Being a part originally granted James M. David & a part Lewis Wells lying as follows beginning at a stake on the East side of Rocky Creek thence running S.E. to a red oak thence S.E. to a stone thence N.E. to a red oak thence eastward to a post oak thence N.W. to red oak thence westward to the Rocky Creek thence down the Creek to the beginning corner including One hundred & fifty acres more or less together with all that appertains to the said land & premises before mentioned to the S^r Brasher Henderson his heirs & assigns forever, Lastly I the said Henry Brasher doth hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the above described land & premises to the S^r Brasher Henderson his heirs & assigns forever all claims that now is or may be made by any person who above claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereunto I set my hand & seal this 25th day of September 1816 Signed & delivered in the presence of Aquila Long

343 State of South Carolina Greenville district, Know all men by these presents that I Jeremiah Bruce of the district of Greenville & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Stuart Thurston of the district & State aforesaid hath granted, bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the S^r Stuart Thurston certain tracts or parcels of land containing two hundred & fifty acres to the same more or less being & lying on both sides of Clear Creek beginning at a maple corner on the north side of Clear Creek bound on the west & north by lands of the S^r Thurston to a post oak corner thence North 89^o E. to a branch or stream: Thence down the branch to the creek thence a straight line to a large Chestnut at the head of Joel Bruce still run then up the S^r branch to the fork then a straight line to Wreys & Marmilians red oak corner thence South 27^o 10' 30" Chain to Stake corner thence a straight line to Carnes branch where the Greenville road crosses leading from Thoms old bridge thence
