 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Rolly Jenkins
 his heirs and assigns forever against myself and my heirs and
 against every other person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof, In Witness whereof I have
 here unto set my hand and seal this 14th day of November

 John Stovall of Greenville District and State aforesaid for & in consider-
 ation of eight hundred dollars in hand paid by Rolly Jenkins
 of the State and district aforesaid, have bargained sold & released
 and by these presents bargain grant sell and release unto the s^d Rolly
 Jenkins all that tract or parcel of land lying and situated in Green-
 ville district and State aforesaid, lying on both sides of the Enoree
 River, whereon the said Stovall now has a Grist mill, Beginning
 on a Pine on the North side of said river near the head of the
 Mill Pond thence due South twenty two chains & twenty five links to
 a red Oak Corner, thence a conditional line of Bensons South
 43 E. 20 ch. 20 l. to a post Oak thence along the road toward the
 mill to a Red Oak, thence a straight course to the river, which
