affection and good will which the said William Thruston
Junr. Bearerth unto Samuel Gibson as also for the better
maintainance and livelihood and support of him the said
Samuel Gibson, hath given granted & released and by these
presents doth give grant and release unto the said Samuel
Gibson his heirs and assigns a certain parcel or part
of a tract of land lying on the west side of the river
supposed to be by computation thirty five acres, be the
same more or less. Beginning on a Branch below the
Schoolhouse spring where Reuben Martens line crosses
thence down said branch to the lower corner of an old
field to a conditional Maple corner made between said
Thruston and said Gibson thence a northwarily direction
a Conditional line to a post Oak Corner above the old field
near the top of the ridge, thence West of North, an open
line to John M. Hansel's line, thence with said Hansel's line
to Reuben Martens line, thence with said Martens line to the
beginning. Together with all and singular the rights mem-
bers hereditaments & appurtenances therunto belonging or
in any wise appertaining; to have and to hold all and
singular the said premises unto the s^d Sam^l Gibson his heirs
and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my
heirs execors & Administrators to Warrant & for ever defend
all and singular the aforesaid Premises unto the s^d Sam^l
Gibson his heirs &c. Against myself my heirs Executors
Administrators and Assigns forever. In Testimony whereof
