

State of South Carolina Greenville district, I know all men by their presents that I William Chandler of the state and district aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Allen Estes of the state and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Allen Estes a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less Situate in the  aforesaid lying on the head waters of Horse Creek beginning at a Post Oak named N 86 East 13 to a Post Oak joining William Mulligans land thence S 6 W. 19. 450. to a stake joining Jonathan Dewise land thence S. 43 E. 19. 450 to red Oak joining Drury Hodges land thence S 86 E 29 450 to a Poplar joining said Hodges land thence N 40 W 56 to the beginning joining Thomas Mulligans land. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Allen Estes his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exor. & Admin^r to Warrant & for ever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the s^r Allen Estes his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, as Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of November in the year of our Lord 1817, & in the forty first year of the independency of the United States of America, signed Sealed & delivered in the presence of
