State of Carolina Greenville County personally came William Howard before me and makes oath as the law directs and saith on said oath that he was present and saw James McLaughlin sign his real act & deed deliver the within deed for the uses & purposes therein contained also that he saw John McLaughlin sign his name with him self as witness to the same Sworn to & subscribed before me this 22nd of May 1799 Just Filigree J.P. [Recorded 29th March 1819] William Howard

I now all men by these presents that I William Hendrix of the state of South Carolina Spartanburg district for the consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Sam. Howard and for the said sum hath granted bargained and sold & by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Sam. Howard of Greenville district to him his heirs executors admrs or assigns one hundred & fifty acres of land more or less all the part of the tract of land of 232 acres of land granted to the said Wm. Hendrix situate lying on Darby's Creek water of Cowee all that part of sd tract of land that lyeth on the south side of said creek exclusive of other surveys for one hundred & fifty acres of land let there be more or less. Together with all the premises & appurtenances thereunto belonging to the only proper and absolute use & behalfe of him the sd Sam. Howard him, his heirs executors administrators or assigns from without any manner of trouble hindrance molestation interruption or denial of him the sd Wm. Hendrix him his heirs executors admrs or assigns or any person or persons but shall & will warrant and forever defend the tract of one hundred & fifty acres of land as aforesaid the land joining the old Indian line & Holloway Powers's land & Stahl's land & Darby's Creek & John Murphy's land. In witness whereof I the said Wm. Hendrix to these have hereunto set my hand & seal this 15th day of January 1818 and in the 42 year of Independence -
