of three hundred dollars to me paid by Robt Goodgion of Greenville  
District, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robt Goodgion a tract or  
parcel of land laying and being in the district of Greenville aforesaid on  
both sides of Greens creek a branch of S. Pacolet river Beginning at  
a red oak near a branch (Stephen Johnsons corner) running thence N. 10<sup>o</sup>.  
22 ch. to a White Oak, thence S. 60<sup>o</sup> W. 26 chains to a forked Cheinut, thence  
N. 10 E. 36 ch. to Stake, thence N. 48 W. 10 chains to a Hickory John  
Evans corner, thence N. 10 E. 32 ch. to a large Poplar, thence N. 125 E.  
12 ch. to a Stake, thence S. 70 E. 60 ch. 50 links to a Stake, Stephen Johnsons  
corner, thence a straight line nearly a S. course with Stephen Johnsons  
line to the head of the nearest branch, thence down the meanders thereof.
