State of South Carolina Know all men by these Presents that I Israel Fowler
of Greenville district, and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of
two hundred and ten dollars to me in hand paid by Solomon Holland of the
district and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and
by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Solomon Holland
a plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the district
and State aforesaid, on North side of bridge fork of Gilders creek water
of Enoree river, it being a part of a tract originally granted to William
Gamlin by his excellency William Moultrie the 1st day of December 1794
the land to be conveyed begins on Poplar on the Creek on said Hollands
line, runs N. 35 W. 27.50 to Stake 34, S. 70 W. 9. to Pine 3x. S 15 E 10 to Stake
34 S 70 W. 30 to rock 34, S 15 E 14 to Stump Stake 34 in John Fowler field
thence with the various meanders of the said creek to the beginning, in-
cluding one hundred and eight acres, be the same more or less. Together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances
to the said premises, belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining,
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Solomon Holland. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Solomon Holland his heirs and
assigns forever against myself, and my heirs and against every other person
whomsoever, claiming or to claim, the same or any part thereof.
