


South Carolina Greenville District. Personally came William Holland before me and being duly sworn on oath says that he was present and saw Israel Fowler assign and deliver the within deed of Conveyance to Solomon Holland for the use and purpose therein mentioned; and also saw Asa Reed assign the same as a concurring Witness with himself. Sworn to and Subscribed before me this 27th day of January 1819. B. Griffith J. D. William Holland

South Carolina Greenville District. I B. Griffith one of the Justices of the Quorum do hereby certify to all whom it may concern that Rachel Fowler the wife of the within named Isaac Fowler did this day personally come before me, & upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she does freely and voluntarily without any compulsion or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and forever relinquish all his interest and estate, also all her right and claim of Dower to the within named Solomon Holland, of in and to the within mentioned and released. ²³ The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents, that I Thomas Pague Sheriff of Greenville District in the said State do send Greeting. Where: as Samuel Richards late of the District and State aforesaid, was lately seized and possessed in his own right, in fee simple, or of and in some other good and sufficient Estate of Inheritance to him and his heirs and assigns forever to all that Messuage, tenement or tract of Land, containing six hundred & thirty three acres, to the same more or less, situate lying and being in the District & State aforesaid, near the head of Reedy River, and Armstrongs Creek; known by the name of the sign of the white horse, and the Robinsons plantation, adjoining, being the same Land, that was conveyed from Elias Earle to ^{the} Samuel Richards by deed bearing date the 22^d of November 1813 & Recorded in the Clerks Office of said District, in book I, page 471 &c. And Whereas George W. Earle, assignee of Elias Earle did lately, to wit, at Greenville Court house in the District and State aforesaid, on or about the first Monday after the fourth Monday in October 1816, (by the confession of the s^d. Samuel) obtain and enter up Judgment against the said Samuel Richards for the sum of Nine hundred and eighteen dollars and seventy five cents, and interest thereon from the 20th of October 1816 until paid (agreeable to a Mortgage given by the said Samuel to the said Elias Earle for the land aforesaid and assigned by the said Elias to the said George W. Earle) And also for the sum of twenty four dollars and eleven cents for costs and charges as may appear by reference to the said proceedings in the Clerks Office aforesaid: In pursuance of which said Judgment there issued from the Office of the Clerk of the said Court a Writ of Fieri Facias, tested at Greenville Court House aforesaid the first Monday after the fourth Monday in March 1818 directed to all and singular the Sheriffs of the said State commanding them, or some one of them, that of the goods and chattels houses lands and other hereditaments & real Estate
