State of South Carolina Greenville district, Personally came Nimrod Underwood before me the subscribing Justice and being duly sworn, saith that he saw John West assign the within instrument of writing, and deliver the same unto William Henson for the use and purpose within mentioned, and that Harriet Underwood was together with himself subscribing witnesses to the same. Walker of Greenville district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred & twenty dollars paid by John Bohannon of the State & district aforesaid have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell to s^d John Bohannon one hundred and thirty eight acres of land lying in s^d district on a branch of the ruddy fork of Ruddy River being part of a tract of land granted to Cadwalder Jones aforesaid by his excellency Tho^s Pinkney on the third day of December 1787 also part of a tract of land granted to Rob^t Gilliam and aforesaid by his excellency Tho^s Pinkney on the seventh day of April 1788 the s^d one hundred and thirty eight acres of land more or less is laid out to the s^d Bohannon as follows beginning on a pine corner on James Creamers land running N 55 W 9 to hickory thence N 33 E 15 25 to a post O thence N 38 W 55 to a stake of James Faromers line thence N 98 E 9 50 to a post O on s^d line thence S 62 E 53 to a post oak on s^d line thence S 6 E 12 to a poplar on Pascal Rutledges line and from thence to the beginning. Including one hundred and thirty eight acres more or less. Together with all that appertains to s^d land & premises or any wise incident. To have and to hold to the s^d John Bohannon his heirs and assigns forever and lastly I the s^d Henry J. Walker doth hereby warrant & forever defend the aforesaid land & premises to the s^d John Bohannon his heirs & assigns forever from myself my heirs & assigns and from all other persons claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th February 1819. In presence of Fleming Thomason, Parkam Pollard, Rob^t Carr, Henry J. Walker Seal

Walker assign and deliver the within deed of conveyance to John Bohannon & that he saw the subscribing witnesses witness the same with himself.
