thence down the meanders of s. branch to the river thence straight along  
a conditional line to the beginning corner containing one huc-  
-ared and fifty acres by estimation to the same more or less  
the same being part of a tract of land granted to Robert Nelson  
as also an other tract joining. Beginning on a black oak thence
