 that John Crawford of the state and District of our said in
 consideration of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge have granted bargained
 sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell &
 release unto Charles Tankersly his heirs & assigns a certain tract
 or parcel of Land containing three hundred & sixteen acres
 more or less situate in Greenville District on both sides of the me-
 -dow fork of Musk Creek and bounded as follows Viz. Beginning
 on a red oak in Leonard Claybourns and Shurds Conditional
 line thence S. 52. W. 4 Chain to a post oak, thence S. 40. W. 38. 50.
 Crossing a creek to a red oak in Wm. Calloways line thence with
 S. 6 line ^{8 chain} to a poplar on a branch thence up a branch with its main
 -dow 15 Chain to a maple, thence to a chusnut oak on the ridge
 Between Grimes Halcombs & Richard Forester, thence North. 11. E. 15.
 to a black gum on a creek, crossing the same N. 5. W. 4. 50 to a
 white oak on a rock in a shoal of a branch, thence S. 48. E. 30. 50.
 to a Spanish Oak on a creek crossing the same N. 15. ^E 37. 50. to a
 Post oak on a ridge path, that leads from Leonard Claybourns to-
 -wards new market, thence S. 55. E. 19. 50. with a path to a red oak,
 thence to the beginning; It being part of sundry tracts of land con-
 -veyed to me by Rich, Forrest & Tho. Edwards as the records of
 Greenville will more fully make appear; together with all and sin-
 -gular the rights members, hereditaments & appertanances to said
 premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have it
 to hold all & singular the land & premises before mentioned unto
 the Charles Tankersly his heirs and assigns for ever, and
