certain bay mare now in the care and keeping of Thomas Payne
Esq. to have and to hold the said mare unto the said his
Executors adm^r. or assigns and I do bind myself my heirs
Executors and administrators to warrant and defend
the said mare unto the said B. J. Carl against any person
whomsoever claiming or to claim the same. The condition
of the foregoing sale is such, that whereas the said James
Dehaffey owes the said B. J. Carl by note of hand of this date
the sum of fifty dollars to be paid on or before the first day of
March Court next now the agreement between the said parties
is that if the said James shall pay or cause to be paid to the
said B. J. Carl the said sum of money according to the tenor
if the said note then the above bill of sale shall be utterly
void and of no effect; but otherwise if the said sum of fifty
dollars should not be paid by the said first day of March
Court next then the same shall remain in full force and virtue
and become absolute power. As witness my hand and seal this
