N. 50. E. with Fords line 42 to a stake 3x. by the road N. 86. E. 11. to a P.O. 3x. thence with Bayons or Talley N. 25 E 54 to a P.O. 3x. B. Spains 3x. S. 10. E 3. 50. to a stake in Billingsleys line N 85. W. 10. to a stake 3x. near a large Hickory 578. with Billingsleys line to a B. gum 3x. Snowden, 3x. with Snowdens line S 73. W. 15. to a stake 3x. in Rolands line thence to the beginning. Together with all and singular the above described premises unto the said Thomas Roland his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the above described premises unto the said Roland from myself & my heirs & against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Know all men by these presents that I Richard Russell for and in consideration of the sum of eight dollars to me in hand paid by the head of Tiger river church both of us of the state and district aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, released unto the said tiger river church a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district aforesaid and being part of a tract laid out for James Chastain and lying on the north side of South tiger, lying at the old tiger meeting house. Beginning at a red oak corner joining Andrew McCarry's land, thence running along the said old original line S 45 W 31-47 rods to a stake corner thence running parallel with the original line joining Andrew McCarry's land 17 rods to a stake corner thence running parallel with the beginning line to the
