to a R. O. 3x. thence with Burton or Dray Tally's N. 25 E. 54 to a R. O. 3x. B. Spain's  
3x. S 10 E 3-50. to a stake in Billingsley's line N. 85 W. 10. to a stake 3x. near  
a large Hickory 578. with Billingsley's line to a B. gum 3x. Sowden's 3x.

house. Beginning at a red oak corner joining Andrew McBray's  
land, thence running along the said old original line S 46 W  
31-47 rod to a stake corner thence running parallel with the  
original line joining Andrew McBray's land 17 rod to a stake  
corner thence running parallel with the beginning line to the
