

twelve degrees west 40 ch^t, to a post oak on a branch, thence up the s^t branch the various course, thence to a maple at the head of said branch, thence N. 64 degrees west 9 ch^t & 75 links, to a Post Oak, thence South 76 and a half degrees west 15 chains to a stake, thence N. 36 degrees west with a conditional line 37 chains, to a red oak, thence N. 60 degrees east 14 ch^t, to a red oak, thence N. 30 degrees west two chains, to a Post Oak, thence N. 63 degrees east 10: to Pointing, thence to the beginning, containing five hundred acres, more or less as aforesaid (all which tract of land I the s^t Jeremiah Wilcox purchased from Tho^r Edwards, s^r of Greenville district by whom the same was conveyed to me in 8 by a title deed bearing date the 24th day of August anno Domini 1815. Recorded in the clerks office of said district in Book I. pages 440, 441 & 442. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Samuel Wilcox his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & adm^rs to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Saml Wilcox his heirs & assigns, against myself my heirs Exec^ts & adm^rs & against all & every person or persons wheresoever lawfully claiming or to claime the same or any part thereof.
