 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell &
 release confirm & convey unto the said Jerusha Pitman all that
 plantation tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & sixty
 seven acres more or less situated lying & being in the state & district
 aforesaid on the head branches of tiger river. Beginning on a chestnut
 thence S 41° W 21 ch^s to a hickory thence S 75° W 22 ch^s to a R. Oak
 thence N 40° W 23 ch^s to a chestnut thence N 54° E 82 ch^s to a stake
 thence S 22° W 47 ch^s to the beginning corner a chestnut, it being a certain
 tract of land granted to Wm. Howard bearing date August the
 31st one thousand eight hundred & fourteen and conveyed from the sd.
 Wm. Howard to Timothy Pitman. Together with all & singular
 the rights, manors, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said
 Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
 To have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Jerusha Pitman her heirs & assigns forever. And
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs & adm^rs. to warrant &
 defend all & singular the sd. premises unto the said
 Jerusha Pitman her heirs & assigns against myself my heirs
 & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my
 hand and seal this 26th day of October 1819. and in the 44th year
 of American Independence. Signed sealed & delivered in presence of
 me Tho^s. Barton, Pleasant Nickman. Timothy J. Pitman
