South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come I Tho^s Payne
Shriff of Greenville district and state aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas,
by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of the court of common
pleas, held for the district of Greenville tested the first Monday after
the fourth Monday of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and eighteen at the suit of Henry Davis against
Robert Alexander Judgment obtained and entered up at Greenville
fall term eighteen hundred and seventeen, to me directed, coman-
-anding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands & tenements, & other
hereditaments & real estate of Rob^t Alexander to levy the sum of
one hundred and seven dollars with interest from the 7th Nov^r 1816
damages and cost, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements
of the said Rob^t Alexander all that certain piece, parcel and tract of
land containing by estimation two hundred and eight acres be the
same more or less, situate and being in the district of Greenville
and state aforesaid on the waters of theuddy fork being part of a tract
of three hundred and eight acres originally granted to James Seaborn
binding on Cox on two sides & on James McDaniel & Cochrane on other
sides &c. And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since
the seizure by me made, by virtue of said writ of fieri facias before men-
-tioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, & purchased by Rich^d
Shuston for James McDaniel of the said district the 3rd of January 1820
for the sum of ninety two dollars that being the highest sum that
was bid therefor: Now know Ye, that I the said Thomas
Payne Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias
