 of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars in hand paid hath
 bargained and sold unto said Thos. Edwards a tract of land contain-
 ing sixty acres more or less lying on the South side of Cain creek branch
 of more river. Beginning on a white oak on the said — then
 running up the branch to Walter Jacobs line thence on the line to
 Thos. Edwards line thence down the line to the beginning corner
 Elizabeth Tomason doth for herself her heirs & executors & adm'ts and
 assigns forever warrant and defend the said tract of land unto
 the said Thos. Edwards his heirs and executors & assigns forever from
 the claims or demands of any person or persons so that from touch-
 ing or conveying the same. In witness whereof I the said Eliza-
 beth Tomason hath hereunto set her hand and seal this 29th day
 of November one thousand eight hundred & fourteen and the thirty-
 third year of American Independence. Signed in the presence of us

 bargain sell and confirm unto the said Pope White all that tract or parcel
 of land lying on the waters of Saluda containing one hundred and
 fifty three acres to the same more or less whereon I now live bounded
 by George Salmon's land and George Vaughan's land and on both
 sides of the Tugalo road and running the various corners will
 appear by reference to the original grant: Being a tract or
 parcel of land purchased by me of John Vaughan together with
 all the improvements, buildings and appurtenances in any wise
