Edwards of the other part witnesses that said Elizabeth Tomason doth for the consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars in hand paid hath bargained and sold unto said Tho<sup>s</sup>. Edwards a tract of land containing sixty acres more or less lying on the South side of Cain creek branch of Moore river. Beginning on a white oak on the said ———— thence running up the branch to Walter Jacobs line thence on the line to Tho<sup>s</sup>. Edwards line thence down the line to the beginning corner Elizabeth Tomason doth for herself her heirs & Executors & assigns and assigns forever warrant and defend the said tract of land unto the said Tho<sup>s</sup>. Edwards his heirs and executors & assigns forever from the claims or demands of any person or persons so that from touching or conveying the same. In witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Tomason hath hereunto set her hand and seal this 29<sup>th</sup> day of November one thousand eight hundred & fourteen and the thirty third year of American Independence. Signed in the presence of us Absolute Cairny, Hubbard Cairny, Jas. Cairny. Elizabeth Tomason

Know all men by these presents that I Nicholas Waddle of the district and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and sixty five dollars to me in hand paid by Sepe White the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and confirmed and do by these presents bargain sell and confirm unto the said Sepe White all that tract or parcel of land lying on the waters of Saluda containing one hundred and fifty three acres be the same more or less whereon I now live bounded by George Salmors land and George Baughans land and on both sides of the Jugalo road and running the various courses will appear by reference to the original grant: Being a tract or parcel of land purchased by me of John Baughan together with all the improvements, incitements, and appurtenances in any way
