 way person or person whatsoever ceased before signing.

 released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 George W. Earle All that Plantation or tract of land, Situate lying and being
 in the district of Greenville aforesaid on Richland Creek and Branches thereof
 containing in the whole about one thousand and seventeen acres: including
 all the lands conveyed to me by Elias Earle in a Deed bearing date the
 twenty eighth day of October Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred
 and thirteen, as represented by a plat annexed to said deed, with the
 exception of fifty acres heretofore conveyed by me to William Thompson adjoin-
 ing his lands, as may appear by the conveyance thereof to him reference being
 thereunto had: Also including Sixty one Acres Conveyed to me by Lemuel S.
 Johnston by deed bearing date the thirtieth day of October Anno Domini
 one thousand eight hundred and thirteen: Also including two tracts
