receive all such sum & sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues,
accounts, and other demands whatsoever, which are due, owing, payable
or belonging to me or detained from me in any manner of ways or
means whatsoever; by any person or persons whatsoever in the district
of Sumner aforesaid. Giving and granting unto my said attorneys
by these presents, full and whole power, strength & authority, in &
about the premises: to have, use, & take all lawful ways & means
in my name for the recovery thereof, & upon the receipt of any such
debts, dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquittances, or other
sufficient discharges; for me & in my name to make, seal & deliver,
and generally all & every other act and acts, thing & things, device or
devices, in the law whatsoever, needful & necessary to be done in &
about the premises, for me & in my name to do, execute & perform,
as fully, largely, and amply, to all intents & purposes, as I might or
could do, if I were personally present, or if the matter required more
special authority than is herein given, & attorneys one or more under
them for the purpose aforesaid, to make & constitute, & again at
pleasure to revoke: ratifying, allowing & holding, for firm effect
-ual, all & whatsoever my said attorneys shall lawfully do in
& about the premises, by virtue hereof. In witness whereof I have
