and by these presents do sell to George Terry all the machinery now in the  
factory at Hadesey Berrys shoals on Reedy River, W.W. One cotton spinning  
frame of 70 spindles one roping frame, of four heads, two cards & all the  
apparatus, therunto belonging to him the said G. Terry. To have & to hold  
the same as collateral security for the payment of two certain notes  
of hand, one payable to Allen King for 108 dollars signed by Shubal  
F. Arnold as principle & said G. Terry as security - one to Alex<sup>d</sup>. Paden for  
one hundred & fifty dollars signed as the above: if the s<sup>d</sup> Arnold shall  
well and truly pay said notes this deed to be void & no effect or  
otherwise remain in full force and virtue. Given under my hand &  
seal the day & year above mentioned. & signed, sealed, & delivered in presence  
of us, wt. John Terry, George Terry. Shubal. F. Arnold <sup>(D)</sup>

that I Hardin Forrest of the state and district above said have  
bargained and sold for the consideration of eighty four dollars  
to me in hand well and truly paid at or before the signing & delivering of  
these presents, a certain tract or parcel of land, containing by estimation  
fifty acres, more or less, lying in the state & district above said on the  
waters of Musch Creek & bounded as follows. Beginning on a red oak  
corner on James Cox land & running on his N. Western line till it  
intersects a small branch which is a conditional line, between Lewis  
Scalf, & Geo. Crawford, thence to continue the meanders of said  
branch to its source at the rock house: thence in a straight direction from  
the rock house till it intersects Hardin Forrest land, & thence to pursue  
his land & lines to the beginning corner; the said land improvements  
every thing thereto appertaining, to Lewis Scalf, his heirs & assigns  
to hold the same forever, from me the s<sup>d</sup> Hardin Forrest & my heirs and  
assigns & from all & every other person from having or laying any just  
right, till a claim thereto. As witness my hand & seal this 22 day of Sept
