Alabama Territory Montgomery county I know all men by their
names that I John B. Blackwell of the county & territory aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to
me paid by James Robertson of the state of S^c Carolina & district
of Greenville have granted bargained sold & released & by these
present do bargain sell & release unto the said James Robertson
a certain parcel or tract of land containing one hundred acres be the
same more or less lying and being in the district of Greenville
& state of S^c Carolina upon the branches of Armstrong creek being
part of a tract of land originally granted to Obadiah Hooper
sen^r & from him conveyed to Richard Hooper & from Richard to
Lewis Mabery & from Lewis to John Cantwell sen^r & from John
to Hugh Cantwell. Beginning upon a turkey oak upon a
conditional line between James Woody & John Cantwell
sen^r running a strait line to the spring where little Sally
Cantwell formerly lived down the said spring branch to
big branch thence down said branch to a conditional line thence to
Tho^s Hooper's line to a stake thence a conditional line made by Rich^d
Hooper & Tho^s Hooper thence to the original corner upon a post oak
thence the original line to a post oak corner on a conditional line
between J^r Cantwell & James Woody thence a conditional line to
a turkey oak corner thence a conditional line to the beginning.
Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining to the same. To have & to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James
Robertson his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my
heirs and assigns to warrant and defend all & singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said J^r Robertson his heirs &
assigns forever against myself heirs & assigns & every other
person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any
part thereof. As witness thereto I have hereunto set my hand
