

175 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Edwards of Greenville district in the state aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and sixty two dollars & fifty cents to me paid by John Gurn of Greenville district in the state aforesaid have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Gurn all that tract or parcel of Land containing sixty acres more or less being a part of two tracts of land one of them originally granted unto Aaron Kemp the 29th day of January 1785. containing one hundred acres, and part of another tract being on the W^e side of the aforesaid tract bounded as follows. Beginning on a white oak on the bank of cane creek of moon river running thence S 30 E 30 ch to a Post oak corner on Gurns line running thence S 75 W 14 ch & 50 ch to a black oak corner thence S 20 W 7 ch to a spanish oak corner new mark thence N 70 W 10 ch to a spanish oak corner new mark thence N 15 W 10 ch to a maple corner on the bank of said maple creek thence down said creek following the meander to the beginning white oak corner which includs the land intended to be conveyed together with all and singular the rights, members, incidents, conditions and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Gurn his heirs or assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exors or admrs to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said John Gurn his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whom own lawfully claim to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the 15th day of July in the year of our Lord 1820. and in the 45th year of the Independance of the united states of AMERICA.
