Hudson Berry a certain parcel of land being part of two ori-
ginal tracts or granted to Wm J Rogers on the 6th of September
1790 Recorded in grants book C. 45 page 404 the other granted
to David Ross on the 20th of Feb 1785 these conveyed Round
to said Compton and said Hammours now from them to S^d
Berry part of the tract S^d Hammours is to warrant that part
of the land that lies on the south side of the Cedar Shoal
branch down to a small branch that comes in on the S^d side
then up S^d little branch southwards to the back line and
S^d Compton is to warrant that part of the land that
lies on the North side of the Cedar Shoal branch & also all
that part that lies on the south side below the above
mentioned little branch situate in the state & district aforesaid
said on the waters of Beay River beginning on a pine.
