Sold and Release and by these presents do Grant Bargain
Sell and Release unto Edward Nash a part or parcel of Land
Containing one acre be the same more or less originally Gra-
anted to Robert M^r. Clinton Sent and from Robert M^r. Clinton to
M^r. M^r. Clinton and from M^r. M^r. Clinton to John Nash situated
in the District afores^d Beginning at a stake near the mill
dam Running E. about 30 yards to a stake corner thence Running
South about 20 yards to a black oak thence Running S^W
W. across the creek to a post oak thence up S^W creek to the
Beginning Corner situated in the District of Greenville and
State afores^d South Rabunus Creek. Together with all &
Singular the Rights members hereditaments appertaining
to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the
Premises before mentioned unto the s^d Edward Nash his
heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self my
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend
all and singular the said Premises unto the s^d Edward
Nash his heirs and assigns against my self or any other
Person lawfully claiming any part thereof witness my
hand this 2^d of October 1818 it being the forty second and
forty third year of independence of the United States of
