 by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the
 said Charles Estis Jun^r all that plantation or tract of land
 containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less situate
 in the District aforesaid lying on the Branches of Beaver-
 raam Creek waters of Saluda River Beginning on a post
 oak 3x on the Road thence bounding on Joseph McCullough's
 land on the south side bounding westwardly on Me-
 ajah Jordan Northwardly on Henry Johnson Eastwardly
 on the wagon Road to the Beginning. Together with all
 and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appur-
 tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular
 the said premises before mentioned unto the said Charles
 Estis his heirs and assigns forever and to him my self
 if my heirs Executors and adm^r. to warrant & for ever defend
 all & singular the said Premises unto the said Charles Estis
 his heirs or assigns against myself and my heirs & against
 every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
 or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my han-
 dle seal this twentyfirst day of March in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty one & in the for-
 ty fifth year of the Independence of the united state
 of America witness.—
