South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I John Cochran called Mordecai John for & in consideration of the sum of sixty Dollars to me in hand paid by William Turner - me both parties being of the State and district aforesaid have bargained & sold a certain tract or parcel of land situate in said District on Free - no creek just above Mathew Cochrans land Beginning on a Rock running thence S. 87 E. 19 chs to a white oak & thence S. 30 W. 14 chs 50. crossing said creek to a stake & thence S 3 E. 4 chs 80 to a maple S. 61 W. 15 chs 50 to a Chestnut & thence N. 45 W. 9 chs to a Locust & thence N. 12. 50 to a stake & thence N. 42 E. 9. 30 crossing said creek to the Beginning - supposed to be Forty two acres be the same more or less it being a tract of land I purchased from John Cochran Jun. Together with with all & singular the rights members Hereditaments & appertinances Belonging or in any wise incident to have & to hold all & singular the before mentioned premises unto the heirs the said Turner his heirs or assigns for ever to whom I warrant and for ever defend the rights against myself and my heirs Executors or Assigns or any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand & seal this seventeenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred & twenty & 45 year of American Independence Signed sealed & Executed in the Presence of
