 Carolina and district of Spartanburg for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand
 paid by James Crow Junior of the State and district aforesaid
 have Granted Bargained and sold unto James Crow Junr. all
 that tract piece or parcel of land lying and being in the State
 of South Carolina and district of Greenville waters of part of
 river, it being part of a tract of land originally granted to
 William Clayton and bearing date 1793 Beginning at a pine
 corner on Charles Whittons land thence running by an agreed line
 Thomas Marewells line stake corner, thence with said line to
 an agreed line running to a pine corner, thence to a hickory thence
 to the Beginning corner containing one hundred & fifty acres be the
 same more or less, Together with all and singular the rights Ten-
 -ements and appurtenances to said land to have and to hold
 unto the said James Crow Junr. his heirs Executors, and adminis-
 trators and assigns against myself my heirs or any other person or
