 June 1804 & by said Gow conveyed to Henry Hill & from
 Hill to John Gowen & Buckner Blasingame making in
 all 388 acres more or less including all the plantations
 & premises whereon the said H. Griffin lives. Together
 with all and singular the lands before mentioned
 unto the said Allen Griffin his heirs & assigns forever
 & I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors & admors. to war-
 rant & forever defend all & singular the premises
 and lands before mentioned unto the said Allen Griffin
 & his heirs against myself & my heirs & against all &
 every other person or persons lawfully claiming or
 to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness
