

Henry Walker one hundred & thirty eight acres of land lying in ²⁶⁰
said district on a branch of the ruddy fork, of ruddy river being part
of a tract of land granted to Cadwalder Jones assigned by his
excellency Tho^s Pinckney on the 3^d day of December 1787 also part
of a tract of land granted to Rob^t William and assigned by his
excellency Tho^s Pinckney on the 7th day of April 1788, the said one
hundred & thirty eight acres of land more or less, laid out to the
said Walker as follows. Beginning on a pine corner on
Sa^d Creamers land running N 55 W 9 to a hickory thence N 33
E 15:25 to a post O thence N 38 W 55 to a stake of James Farmers
line thence N 28 E 8:50 to a post O on said line thence S 62 E 53
to a post on said line thence S 6 E 12 to a poplar on Paschal
Rutledges line & from thence to the beginning including one hundred
and thirty eight acres of land more or less. Together with all that
appertains to said land & premises or any wise incident. To have &
to hold to the said Henry Walker his heirs & assigns forever & lastly
I the said John Bohannon doth hereby warrant & forever defend
the aforesaid land & premises, to the said Henry Walker his heirs
and assigns forever from myself my heirs & assigns & from all other
persons claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness where

granted, bargained & sold and by these presents do grant, sell & release
unto the said Tho^s Goldsmith a plantation or tract of land
situate in the State & district aforesaid on both sides of the south
fork of Martins creek waters of Enore river originally granted
to Wm Stul & conveyed to John Stul & from said Stul to Benjⁿ
Hilgou and from said Hilgou to Sa^d Hilgou & from said
Hilgou to Wm Cannady & from said Cannady to James
