






The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents, that I Ridden Hall of the state of Kentucky, Allen county in consideration of five hundred dollars to me paid by Sabas Clark of the district in the state of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold & released & by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Sabas Clark all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred & twenty acres more or less situate in the district of Greenville lying on the branches of Mountain Creek waters of Saluda river. Beginning on a post oak 3x thence N 5 E 22:75 to a pine 3x bounding on land surveyed for Wm. Wood thence N 79 E 20 to a stake 3x thence N 60 E 15:90 to a stake 3x bounding on Archibald. McDonalds land thence S 19 E 25:80 to a post oak 3x bounding on Tully Holdings land thence S 35 W 14:20 to a stake 3x bounding on Luke Crumptions land thence N 45 W 5:50 to a red oak 3x thence S 89 W 31:20 to the beginning bounding on Hawks land (It being two surveys of land one of 15 1/4 acres originally granted to John McDonald on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1804. the other 96 acres surveyed for Ridden Hall the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 1819.) Together with all and singular the right, number, hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises, here mentioned unto the said Sabas Clark his heirs, & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & admors to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said Sabas Clark his heirs and assigns, against myself, my heirs, & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nineteen, and in the forty third year of the Independence of the United States of America.
