Cullough all that plantation or tract of land containing three hundred and sixty acres (more or less) Situate in the district aforesaid lying on Horse Creek and the branches of said river beginning on a white oak 3x running thence N 60 E 31 E 62 to a red oak 3x and thence N 30 E 6.00 to a Hickory 3x thence N 76 E 2.50 to a Stake 3x thence N 15 E 16.00 to a red oak 3x near a branch thence up the meanders of said branch about N 15 W 50 to a red oak 3x thence S 60 W 65.00 to a beach 3x on Horse Creek thence down the meanders of said Creek 12 Chains to a Stake 3x thence S 30 E 51.50 to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph M. Cullough his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph M.
