bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Francis Pace a tract of Land containi-
-ng one hundred Aers more or less situate on the S^o fork of Tyger
River Greenville district and on the small branches of the Elush
Creek Waters of Tyger River beginning on a black oak running thence
S^o 20 E 44-72 to a post oak corner, thence to a Spanish oak corner
N^o to the head of Madams branch thence down the branch to
a maple on the old line thence to the beginning corner
Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments
and appertinances to the S^o premises belonging or anywise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Francis Pace his
heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
Exor^t & adm^r to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the s^d Francis Pace his heirs & assigns
against myself and my heirs & assigns & every other person
