& entered into by James Blakeley of the one part and Miles Owens of
the other part Witnesseth that the said parties doth agree at the settle-
ment at present that is to say that the said Blakeley doth agree to
give up to said Owens that lot the Cabin is in and also the said
Blakeley doth at Christmas in 1821. the is to relinquish all claims and
titles to the land where he now lives the said Blakeley is not to prohib-
it said Owens from sowing wheat in due time also he is to give her
three head of Cattle and three head of hogs one bed and furniture also
he gives her up all the pewter and one trunk and the big pot and wheel
and cards and likewise in the fall 1821. they to have an arbitration
respecting the repairs of the buildings in witness whereof we here set
our hands and seals this the 6th day of Nov. 1820

Crowder Sheriff of Greenville district, and State aforesaid send
Greeting: Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of
the Court of Common Pleas held for the district of Greenville
tested the first monday after the fourth monday of October in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, at
the suit of James Pool against John Chandler to me directed
