paid by Christopher Lowndes of the State of Maryland and
Prince George County have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
Said Christopher Lowndes all that plantation or tract of land
Containing three hundred and eighty five acres more or less lying
in the State and district just above mentioned being a tract
Granted to Dury Morris bearing date 13th October 1804 and lying
on the water of Mountain Creek a branch of Saluda River and
having such shape form and marks as the original plat
representing joining lands of Charles Avery Wm Holladay John
Cochran Thos Chapman Robert Avery and George Avery Together
with all and singular the right Members hereditaments and
appurtenances to the S^d premises belonging or in anywise inua-
-nt or appertaining to have and to hold all & Singular
the premises before mentioned unto the S^d Christopher Lowndes
his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our
heirs Executors and administrators firmly by these presents to
Warrant and forever defend all and Singular the premises to
the Said Christopher Lowndes his heirs and assigns against our
-selves our heirs and all the Legatees of Dury Morris does and
from no other person witness our hands and Seal this 19th of
July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
Twenty one and in the forty sixth year of the Independence of the
United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in the
presence of William Berry Christopher Chapman
