S 15 E 27 Ch. 80 to black oak 3x thence S 60 W 31 Ch. 60 to a pine 3x N 15 W 40
Ch. to the beginning including one hundred acres to have & to hold the
said tract of land as above ascribed unto the said George Tankersley his
heirs & Executors &c. to warrant & forever defend the same & every part
thereof unto the said George Tankersley & his heirs Executors &c. against me
& mine & against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same

my Seal this 7 day of Sept. 1820 & of independence of these united States
