 to the Beginning corner Together with all and singular
 The rights members hereditaments and appertainments
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 appertaining to have and to hold all & singular
 The premises before mentioned unto the said Tho^s
 Hooper and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
 Administrators and assigns to warrant & forever
 defend the above mentioned premises from myself
 my heirs and from every other person or persons
 Whosoever claiming or to claim the same or
 any part thereof to the said Tho^s Hooper his heirs
 or assigns for ever in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this 24th day of
