Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Mayfield
of the State and District aforesaid for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to
me in hand paid by James Sutherland of the State
and District aforesaid hath Granted Bargained
Sold and Released and by these presents do
Grant Bargain and Release unto Mr James
Sutherland of the State and District
aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the State and District aforesaid
Lying on the South side of Gap Creek of the
middle fork of Saluda containing one hundred
Acres more or less beginning on Spruce pine
Conditional Line made between Jonathan Potts
and William Cannon then running South to a bold
Line three a long the S. line to the south branch
of the Creek to the south foot of a branch thence down
said branch to the mouth to a parallel corner thence up
the Creek to the beginning corner on a Spruce pine
it being a part of a tract of land Granted to
John Colcock surveyed for Ephrem Elles which
Mr Mayfield hath sold to James Sutherland
to have and to hold the said land and premises him
