come I Wm W. Cravender Sheriff of Greenwich Dist
and State of aforesaid send Greeting: Whereas by Order
of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court
of Common Pleas held for the district of Greenwich
Tested the first Monday after the fourth Monday of
October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
Hundred and Twenty at the suit of George Miller
against Edward Stewart junior to me directed
Commanding me that of the goods and Chattels
lands and tenements of Edward Stewart junior to levy
the sum of two hundred dollars and interest damages
and costs I have seized and taken of the Lands
and tenements of the said Edward Stewart junior
all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land
containing sixty two acres ^{more or less} situate and being
in the District of Greenwich on the north side of
the Beaver dam creek a branch of the Middlefork
of Tyger River being the North End of a survey
granted to Augustus Murick bearing date Janry
13. 1787 Beginning at a white oak running thence
N 15° E 100 Chs to a Hickory thence N 82° E 23 Chs
to a red oak thence S 16° E 16 Chs to a stake on the
Bank of the creek thence up the meanders of creek
to the beginning and where of the said premises
with heir appurtenances since the seizure by
