District in the State aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of one hundred Dollars cash to
me paid by Willis Hicks of the State and District
aforesaid Have granted, bargained sold released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Willis Hicks, all that tract or parcel
of Land situate in said District on the waters of
Sausal Creek containing one hundred and thirty
acres be the same more or less Bounded on William
Griffith, Walton Knight Harmon Hicks and the
said Robert Alexander's land being land originally
granted to James Hubbs and sold for partition and
division as lot number 7 being part of the said lot
sold by the Sheriff of said District it being a balance
of 113 acres of said lot no. 7 together with all and singular
the rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
