shall come I A. W. Browder Sheriff of Greenville  
District and State aforesaid send greeting  
whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias  
issued out of the Court of Common Pleas  
held for said District, tested the first mon-  
-day of the fourth month of October  
in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and Twenty two at the  
Suit of Andrew Culbertson, to me directed  
Commanding me, that of the goods and chat-  
-ter lands and tenements of James Porter & wife  
to levy the sum of Three hundred and twenty nine  
dollars eleven cents, damages and costs, I have seiz-  
-ed and taken of the lands and tenements  
of the said James Porter & wife, all that certain  
piece, parcel and tract of land, con-  
-taining four hundred and twenty six  
acres, situate and being in the District of  
Greenville aforesaid on the north side of
