sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars to us in hand
paid by Lawrence Brock and Henry Brock
or otherwise called L. H. Brock have
granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain
sell & release unto the said Lawrence Brock
and Henry Brock all that tract planta-
tion or parcel of land situate lying
and being on the north side of Tyger River
in the District aforesaid containing by
resurvey Four hundred and twenty six
acres having such shape lines boundaries
marker buttings and haundings as are represent-
ed in a plat thereof which is hereunto
annexed reference being thereunto had made
by Daniel Willbentis on the Eleventh day of
March Eighteen hundred and fifteen
being a tract or plantation on which
we now live and the same conveyed to me
the said Mary Porter by deed from Mr D. J. Bu-
cherston dated the the sixth day of April
Eighteen hundred and four being part
of the real Estate of William D Thomas
and together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and
