E 40. 50. to a white oak 3x in the Indian boundary line thence S 47 1/2 W. 35. on said line to a post oak 3x thence N 33. W. 9. 25. to a white oak 3x at the head of a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to a rock 3x at its confluence of a larger branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the beginning, it being the tract of land occupied by the aforesaid Jacob Nabours deceased) Together with all and singular the rights, members, incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Matlock his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby jointly and severally bind our selves and each of our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Matlock his heirs and assigns against our selves and our heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
