dollars to me in hand paid by William  
Barton of the State and District aforesaid  
have bargained granted, sold and released  
and do by these presents bargain grant sell and  
release, unto the said William Barton, a plantation  
or parcel of land lying and being in the  
District aforesaid on both sides of the Sink hole  
fork of Tyger River Beginning on a post  
oak thence North eighty chains to a stake on  
the side of the glapy mountain thence East to the bran-  
ch that leads down from Thomas Bowers thence  
down the meanders of said branch to Michael  
Prewitts line thence a west direction on Prewitts  
line to the corner next William Howards, thence  
on said Howards line to the creek below  
his Plantation, thence down the Creek to the mouth  
of a branch that enters into the Creek, thence  
South till it strikes the line in the grant called  
Bear skins line thence west on said line to the  
beginning corner containing by estimation three  
hundred acres more or less being a part
