ed sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver to the said Moses Cook, of the district and state aforesaid all that part of a tract of land originally granted to me the said Micajah Jenkins by His Excellency William Maultrie on the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred and eighty six and in the tenth year of the Independence of the united States of America for eighty acres lying on the north side of Rudy River Beginning on a post oak being the original corner running on the original line to a stake X. on the old Ketch road, from thence to a black oak X: on said road from thence to a pine X. on the the beginning line be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to to the said premises, belaning or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises be fore mentioned to the said Moses Cook, his heirs and assigns to their proper use and behoof. and I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators firmly to warrant and forever defend, and all and singular the premises be fore mentioned to the said Moses Cook his heirs and assigns and against my self my heirs and assigns and against all persons whomsoever claiming or to claim
