Gift unto Henry Cannon of the State and District

same more or less, the other lying on Tyger below
the Milford tract bounded on one side by Jesse
~~Ballinger~~, land on the other side by John Watsons
land Deceased containing one hundred and seven
by two acres be the same more or less also all
the property conveyed to me from Henry Cannon,
my dear son, in the year Eighteen hundred & Twelve together with
all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurten
ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertain
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Henry Cannon, his
heirs and assigns forever against myself or any other person
claiming the same or any part thereof in witness whereof
I have set my hand and seal this fourth day of
April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
and eighteen in the forty second year of the In
dependence of the United States of America
