

presents that Lewis Sudduth of Greenville Distr-  
-ict in the State aforesaid, in consideration  
of one hundred Dollars paid by Pleasant  
Hudson of Greenville District and State aforesaid  
the said Lewis Sudduth, have granted bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Pleasant  
Hudson, a plantation or Tract of Land, contain-  
twenty acres lying in the District and State aforesaid  
on the North side of brushy creek the waters  
of Enoree River, it being a part of a tract  
of land originally granted to Henry Hughes, dated  
the fifth day of February in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty  
seven, whereas begining on a sweet gum on the bank  
of said creek running thence N 42 W 33 ch to a  
saw wood on a small branch from thence  
S. 12 W. 11.50 L. with the meanders of the said branch  
to a black gum corner on the bank of the said  
brushy creek from thence down with the  
meanders of S. creek to the beginning corner,  
together with all and singular the right
